Definition of a significant hazard is a hazard that is an actual or potential cause or source of:

- Serious harm; or
- Harm that does not usually occur or usually is not easily detectable until a significant time after exposure to the hazard; or
- Harm that depends on the extent of the frequency to the person's exposure to the harm.
